Of the things we think, say or do:


- 1. Is it the TRUTH?



GG-1412665 Project Updates *Rotary e-Books Reading Centers* Nicanor "Nick" Baterina



On Sept. 11, 2015, TRF through Kim accepted Ms. Hanae our requested revision in the implementation of this project. The revision involves the elimination of the security cables and IR key. The amount budgeted for these items, Php504,800, will be reallocated to buying more tablets and related furniture. In lieu of the security cables and IR key, a no-cost

security system will be implemented by the schools. This system is akin to the management of library books & periodicals. The librarian is the custodian of the tablets, 10 per school. A user submits a request slip and the librarian issues the tablet. Usage and return are monitored by a borrower's card.

Twenty schools, double the original, will benefit from the elimination of the security hardware and the reduced prices of tablets and tables.

The fabrication of the tables for the initial 10 schools is almost complete. PP Radian placed the PO for the initial 100 tablets with PC Express on Sept. 12. Marikina DepEd is presently downloading the public domain e-books that will be uploaded by Rotarians. Additional POs will be placed.
