wish to inform you that I have accepted the invitation by District Governor Julie Mason of
District 9800 (Victoria, Australia) to engage District 3800 to the Group Vocational Exchange
(GVE) Program this Rotary Year 2015-2016. GVE Program is a one-month long cultural and
vocational exchange program for professional men and women, aged between 25 and 40
years. Each exchange team is comprised of a Rotarian acting as the team leader and four
specially selected team members. Our GVE Team will have the opportunity to travel to
Australia, stay with Rotary families and learn more about the vocation and the culture of

Australia. Likewise, their GVE Team will have the same opportunity as they visit our District. Our District will shoulder the airfares, travel taxes and terminal fees of the team, while their month long stay will be hosted by the Rotarians of District 9800 and their families. Other incidentals like travel insurance, uniforms, presents to the host families will be shouldered

by the participants.

I am asking you and your club to participate in this program by nominating an applicant for our team this year. The participants to be nominated must come from these following professional or work background, as follows: Basic Education and Literacy, Economic and

Community Development, Disease Prevention and Treatment, Water and Sanitation, Peace

and Conflict Prevention/Resolution and Maternal and Child Health.

Your nominee will undergo a screening process, and whoever will be selected to the team will surely have a wonderful opportunity to gain an understanding of how their role functions in overseas countries and hopefully bring back ideas and initiatives to benefit their respective employers and profession. I ask that you publicise this wonderful opportunity in your Bulletins, and on your Facebook page and website, so that we encourage suitable young people to experience this wonderful Rotary sponsored program.
