MEMO on the Oct. 8 Meeting between RCMW & DepEd Marikina



Key Results of Discussions (PP Nick added some post-meeting developments):

#### 1. Project Status

a. The Rotary Foundation (TRF) has approved the RCMW-proposed changes in the procurement. The security cables and IR key, costing Php504,800 will be deleted. In lieu of this, the Cooperating Org'n (DepEd Marikina) will put in place a no-cost tablets management system, akin to the traditional library management system of books and other periodicals.

- b. The cost saving will be used to buy more tablets and related furniture. Based on current cost estimates, this translates to additional 11 beneficiary schools on top of the original 10.
- c. Procurement of tablets (210 units)
  - First 100 units (Samsung brand) already delivered by PC Express to PP Radian Fantone and needed apps are being setup. Installation of apps may take some time as he can only do this during his spare time. He's looking at 2-3 weeks to install for the first 100 units.
- Purchase Order for additional 110 (Lenovo brand) units already submitted to Villman Computer Systems. Completion of order may take 2-3 days. Delivery would be after clearing of check. Estimated delivery would be week of Oct. 12.
- d. Fabrication of tables (42 pcs) & reading stands (210 pcs)
  - Each beneficiary school will receive 2 tables (2' x 4') and 10 reading stands.
  - Fabricator is just waiting for the delivery schedule to apply the finish coats including duco finish.



- 2. DepEd Marikina (c/o Dr. Cena) will provide RCMW the list of the 21 beneficiary schools. Deadline: Oct. 12
- 3. RCMW, c/o PP/Atty. PP Levi Ugsad, will prepare the draft of the MOU. Deadline: Oct. 16. For review of DepEd Marikina.
- 4. DepEd Marikina will prepare the list of public domain e-books that it will download. Deadline: Oct. 16. Files should be in .EPUB format. Uploading to the e-books will be by Rotarians, managed by PP Radian Fantone. DepEd Marikina offered to assist in the uploading this will be relayed to PP Radian.
- 5. DepEd Marikina will prepare the Tablets Management System to address the security and integrity concerns on the tablets & related furniture. This will be included as an attachment to the MOU.
- 6. DepEd Marikina will continue to conduct impact measurement, including surveys of library utilization before and after the installation of the e-books.
- 7. DepEd Marikina will study how the e-books may be utilized not only as reading medium but also as a teaching aid. (Below is part of the comments of TRF when we were applying for a Global Grant.)
  - ... in order to make this project stronger and eligible, stronger training component should be added on this project such as training for teachers on how to teach using the tablets, specific training for educational software on the tablets that can be used with students, or a curriculum developed using the tablets (and training on the curriculum)...
- 8. RCMW to consider providing Rotary-brand stickers to be placed at the back of the tablets as well as alongside the skirt of the tables.
- RCMW will provide specs/descriptions of tablets & associated items that will be donated to the DepEd Marikina. DepEd Marikina will incorporate this info in its supply management.
- 10. Oct. 16 start of delivery of tables & reading stands. Delivery will be at DepEd Marikina. DepEd Marikina will coordinate with beneficiary schools for the delivery to their respective schools. - 11. Oct. 19: start of delivery of tablets to DepEd Marikina for uploading by DepEd Marikina of e-books. The list should include, among others, the serial # of each tablet. (Note: uploading of e-books will be collaboratively done by Rotarians and DepEd Marikina, under the management of PP Radian Fantone.)
- 12. November 9: target start of turn-over. DepEd Marikina will review its schedule considering the Palarong Pambansa and other activities. PP/Ex-Councilor Bojie Bernardino will coordinate with DepEd Marikina on the turn-over.
- 13. Contact details < removed, see separate e-mail>
- 14. Additional pictures of tables/reading stands (without finish coats yet). The reading stands are shown temporarily placed on the table. The final installation involves screwing them to the table at pre-determined spots.
