GLOBAL GRANT PROJECT 1412665 "ROTARY E-BOOKS READING CENTERS" MOA SIGNING & TURNOVER CEREMONIES

On the morning of 7th December 2015, Rotarians, Department of Education-Marikina (DepEd-Marikina) officials, and School Principals converged at the 4th floor AVR of the DepEd Building to witness the formal launch of the ROTARY E-BOOKS READING CENTERS - a Global Grant Project initiated by the Rotary Club of Marikina West (RCMW) and its sister-club, the Rotary Club of Taipei Tienmou (RCTM).

A Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) was signed among RCMW, RCTM, and DepEd-Marikina.

Benefiting from this project are twenty-one (21) public schools in Marikina City. Each beneficiary school would be receiving two tables, ten reading stands, two electrical outlets, and ten tablets with e-books installed on them. A mix of Samsung and Lenovo tablets were donated for each set.

This project took two years in the making with the Global Grant Project applied to The Rotary Foundation during the term of then-President Nick Baterina (Rotary Year 2013-2014) to which he acted also as the primemover and project coordinator seeing to its realization during the term of President Danny Chua (Rotary Year 2015-2016). Also, providing significant assistance to the project was Past President Bojie Bernardino who was the liaison between RCMW and DepEd-Marikina. On the technical side, it was Past President Radian Fantone who procured the tablets and did the manual setup of the two hundred ten (210) TABLETS by installing the needed applications such as the e-book reader and uploading of the e-book files to the tablets. The actual list of e-books were provided by DepEd-Marikina

In attendance for the MOA signing and turnover ceremonies from the Rotary Club of Marikina West were: President Danny Chua, Past President Nick Baterina, Past President Radian Fantone with Ann Nora, Past President Bojie Bernardino, Dir. Jerry Crispino, and Past President Jun Bohol. Rotaractor George Reyes also provided logistical support during the ceremonies.

Other Rotarians witnessing the said event came from partner Rotary clubs, namely: President Boggs Anastacio and Past President Ebbs Baldoz from the Rotary Club of Marikina Uptown, Past President Odie Zafra and President-Elect Mylene Guevara from the Rotary Club of Marikina North, and Past President Nick Marcelo from the Rotary Club of Marikina Central. Other participating clubs were: Rotary Club of Marikina, Rotary Club of Marikina, Rotary Club of Metro Marikina, Rotary Club of San Mateo, and Rotary Club of Rodriguez.

On the same day in the afternoon, two schools had their turnover ceremonies and received the actual donation. Several turnover ceremonies are also lined-up at the various locations of the beneficiary schools this week up to next week.

Source of funds were provided by the two lead clubs - RCMW and RCTM - plus the eight other local clubs and The Rotary Foundation. It is also worth mentioning that a significant amount for funding was obtained from the District Designated Fund of R.I. District 3800 during the incumbency of then-District Governor Louie Ticman (Rotary Year 2013-2014).

Total project cost = US\$ 37,959.00
